MATCH INDEX

LOCAL RULES

(To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf)

Penalty for breach of local rule Match Play, loss of hole, Stroke Play, 2 strokes

1. Out of Bounds

- (a) Those areas beyond the club's boundary fences.
- (b) Those areas beyond any line of white stakes with black tops.
- (c) Those areas beyond black lines painted on permanent structures adjacent to the clubhouse.

2. Ground Under Repair

- (a) Those areas defined by white stakes and/or lines.
- (b) Except in a hazard, clearly defined wheel ruts made by a mower, tractor or motor vehicle.

3. Ground Under Repair – Play Prohibited

Cultivated garden beds are to be treated as Ground Under Repair from which play is prohibited. If such a condition interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player **MUST** take relief as provided in Rule 25-1b(i) (Abnormal Ground Conditions).

4. Ornamental Trees and Shrubs

If a tree or shrub which is staked interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player **MUST** take relief as provided in Rule 24-2b(i) (Immovable Obstructions).

5. Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Green

The specimen Local Rule in Appendix 1 of the Rules of Golf is in effect – see page 134.

6. Integral Parts of the Course

All roads, paths and tracks (other than those which have manufactured edges or those constructed of concrete, bitumen or introduced surfaces) are integral parts of the course; the ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable – Rule 28 applies.

7. Power Lines

If a ball strikes an overhead power line, the player must disregard that stroke and play another ball as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was last played in accordance with Rule 20-5.

8. Practice Areas

- (a) The area defined by the lines formed by blue stakes.
- (b) The practice putting green and its grass apron behind the 10th tee.

9. Kangaroo Damage to Bunkers

Footprints left by kangaroos in bunkers may be treated as Ground Under Repair. Relief is denied if the only interference from this condition applies to the player's stance.

10. Stakes

All stakes, other than those defining the boundaries of the course, are deemed to be immovable obstructions. When stakes and lines are used to define hazards or G.U.R., the stakes identify the hazard or G.U.R. and the lines define the margins.

11. Temporary Immovable Obstructions

A temporary immovable obstruction (TIO) is a non-permanent artificial object erected for special events which is fixed or not readily movable. The specimen Local Rule in Appendix 1 of the 2008 Edition of the Rules of Golf is in effect – see page 135.

Distance Markers – show distances to the centre of the green.

Siren Signals

- One long blast, mark ball and suspend play.
- Two long blasts, replace ball and continue play.
- Repeated short blasts, abandon play.

Slow Play

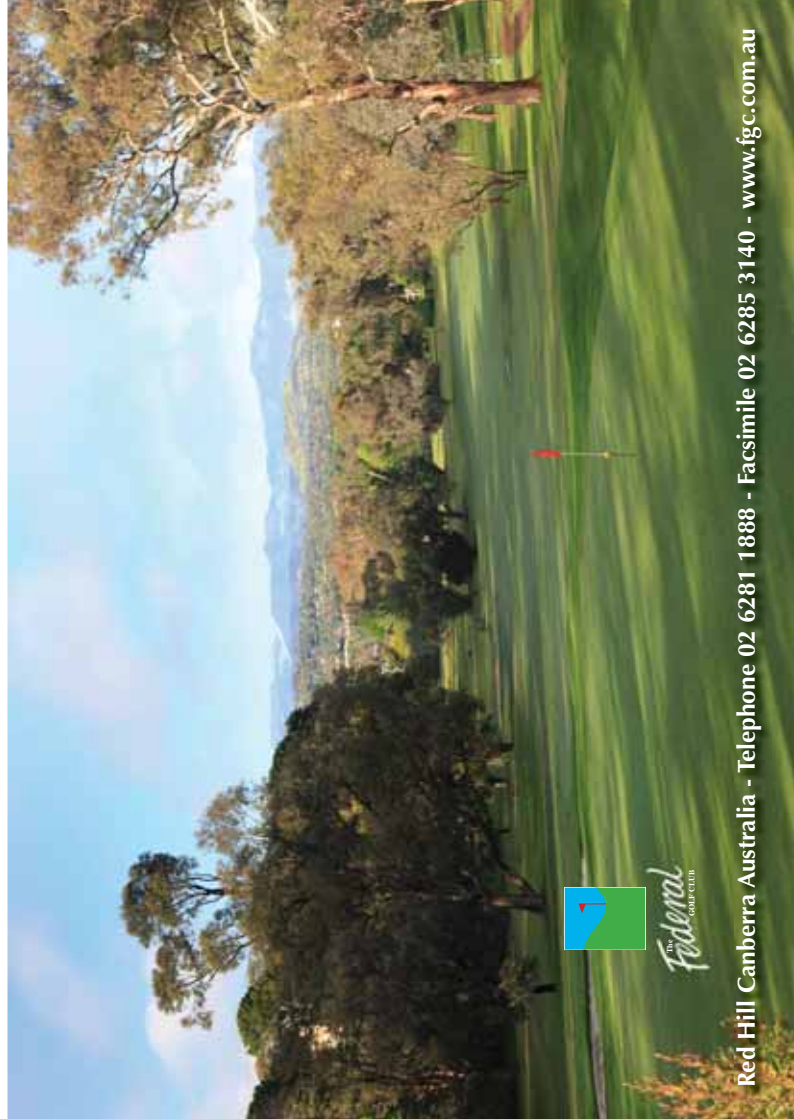
- The first group teeing off has a responsibility to ensure they lead the field for a 4 hour round.
- All players are responsible for keeping up with the group ahead.
- Player must report to the starter 15 minutes before play.

To assist in maintaining our golf course, please:

- Carry and use sand buckets,
- Repair pitch marks,
- Rake bunkers and replace rake on the floor of the bunker along the line of play.

A device to gauge distance may be used provided its only function is to measure distance.

Enjoy the kangaroos, remember they are wild animals. Treat them with respect and caution.
